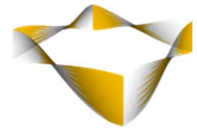


1. Introduction

[JaJuMa Auto Select Options](#) for Magento 2 improves the user experience in your store by automatically selecting configurable & custom options on your product detail pages. For best accuracy of selected options, matching what the customer is looking for, the selection is applied based on several configurable rules with different priorities.

The extension leverages Browser local storage to remember customer's previous selections as base for auto-select rules. By this, customer's will find their preferred option to be automatically applied again, even when access the site again after closing the Browser.

Please see below for more details and configuration options provided by this extension.



2. Installation

For installing the extension, follow installation process as with any Magento Extension.

2.1. Extension Installation via composer

For installing the extension via composer, follow installation process as with any Magento Extension from Magento Marketplace.

2.2. Manual Extension Installation via FTP

For manual installation by FTP, please follow these steps:

Before Installing

1. We recommend you to duplicate your live store on a staging/test site and try installation on your staging/test site before deploying to your live store
2. Backup Magento files and the store database

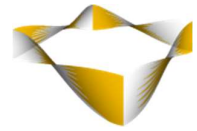
Please Note: It's very important to backup all themes and extensions in Magento before installation, especially when you are working on a live server.

We strongly recommend you to do not skip this step.

Upload the Extension

1. Log into your hosting space via a FTP client (e. g. FileZilla, WinSCP, cuteFtp)
2. Create Folder: <magentoroot>/app/code/Jajuma/AutoSelectOptions
3. Unzip extension package and upload files into:
<magentoroot>/app/code/Jajuma/AutoSelectOptions
4. Enter and run the following commands at the command line:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade  
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```



3. Extension Scope

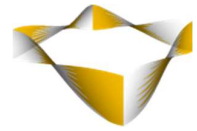
[JaJuMa Auto Select Options](#) for Magento 2 automatically selects configurable & custom options on your product detail pages. The selection is applied based on several rules with different priorities.

The extension leverages Browser local storage to remember customer's previous selections as base for auto-select rules. By this, customer's will find their preferred option to be automatically applied again, even when access the site again after closing the Browser.

3.1. Auto Selection Rules + Priorities

This extension supports auto selection for

- Configurable options based on rules and priorities as described in section **3.1.1 - Configurable Options** and
- Custom Options as described in section **3.1.2 - Custom Options**



3.1.1. Configurable Options

Configurable Options can be auto selected based on following rules and priorities:

1. First available option (Optional, if enabled):

When a customer comes to a product page with configurable options, the first available options will be automatically selected.

Auto selection of first available options are overruled by selections by Super Attribute / per SKU:Prio 2: Previous selection of customer for an attribute

2. By Super Attribute (Optional, as configured):

For "Super Attributes", the last selected option for this attribute by customer will be remembered and applied globally to any SKU with the same configurable option.

Selections remembered for a Super Attribute are overruled by selections per SKU:

3. Per SKU (Default, always enabled):

Configurable option selections by customer for a certain SKU are remembered and automatically re-applied when customer come back to this SKU.

Auto selections based on previous selections by customer per SKU have the highest priority and are always applied if available.

3.1.2. Custom Options

Auto selection for Custom Options is only supported by SKU, based on previous selection of customer for the same SKU.

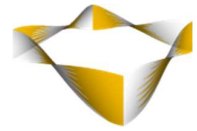
Supported custom option types for auto selection:

- Drop-Down
- Radio
- Checkbox

Additionally, customer inputs in custom options type:

- Text Field &
- Text Area

are remembered per SKU and automatically input again when customer come back to same SKU.



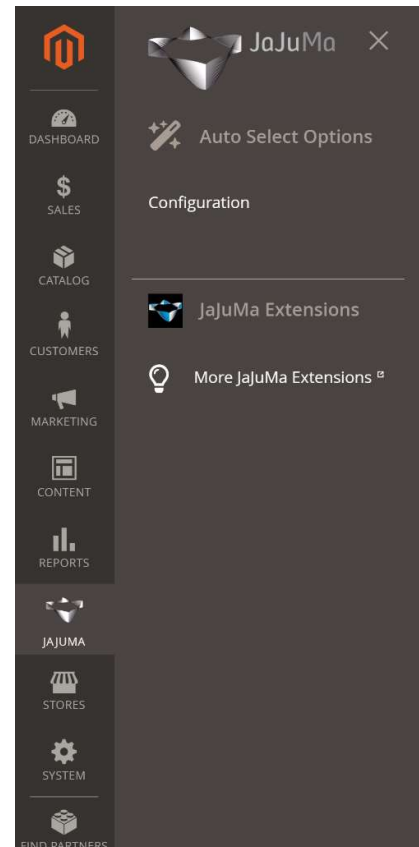
4. Configuration

In Magento Backend see

JaJuMa -> Auto Select Options -> Configuration

to enable or disable the extension and configure the extension.

4.1. General Configuration

The general configurations in

JaJuMa -> Auto Select Options -> Configuration

provide the option to

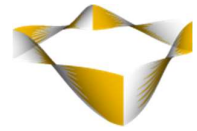
- Enable/Disable the extension
and
- Configure the modules auto select rules and behavior

4.1.1. Enable/Disable

The “Enable” dropdown allows you to enable / disable the Auto Select Options extension:

- Yes → Auto Select Options is enabled
- No → Auto Select Options is disabled

4.1.2. Auto select only after user interaction

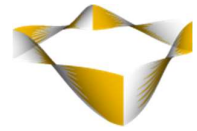
The “Auto select only after user interaction” dropdown allows you to choose if Auto Select Options should be applied only after user interaction was detected or not.

- If Yes: Auto selection of configurable/custom options will only be applied after user interaction
- If No: Auto selection of configurable/custom options will be applied immediately on page load

Select "Yes" to avoid any impact on your Page Speed and Core Web Vitals KPIs.

Auto select only after user interaction [store view]

Select "Yes" to avoid any impact on your Page Speed and Core Web Vitals KPIs.



4.2. Auto Select Configs

The Auto Select configurations in

JaJuMa -> Auto Select Options -> Auto Select Configs

provide the option to configure the auto select rules and behavior.

You can choose to

- Auto select first available options and
- Select Super Attributes for global auto selection based on customer's previous selections on other SKUs

4.2.1. Auto select first available option

The "Auto select first available option" dropdown allows you to choose if first available option should be Auto Selected when customer comes to a product page.

- If Yes: First available configurable options will be automatically selected as fallback if no other auto select rule applies.
- If No: First available configurable options will not be automatically selected as fallback.



4.2.2. Choose Super Attributes

For attributes selected as "Super Attributes" from multi-select config, a customer's selection will be applied globally.

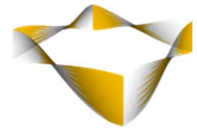
This means, for other SKUs the customer did not visit before, but have the super attribute as configurable option, customer's last selection for this attribute will be applied automatically.

- Color
- Size
- Format

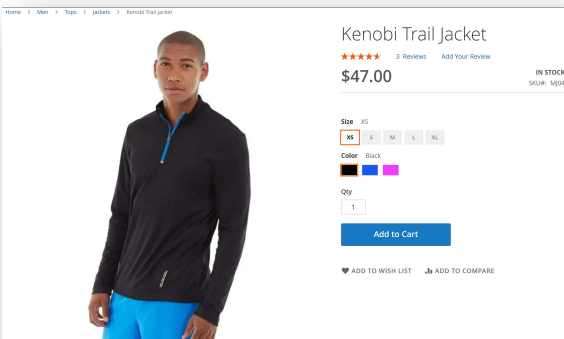

See following example of a user journey with this extension enabled and configured to auto-select first option and with color and size selected as super attributes:

Step 1: John visits product page [Kenobi Trail Jacket](#) – His size is "L" and he likes "blue"

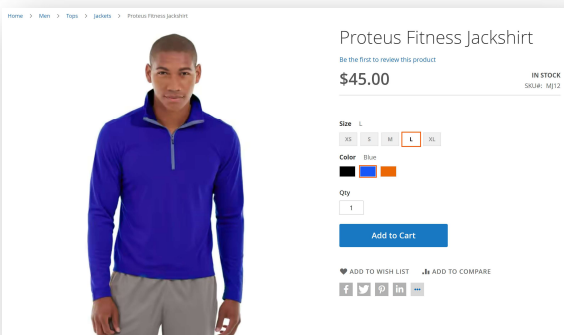
→ First available options are auto-selected

→ John selects size "L" and color "blue"



Step 2: John visits product page [Proteus Fitness Jackshirt](#)

→ Size "L" and color "blue" auto-selected as previously selected for super attributes

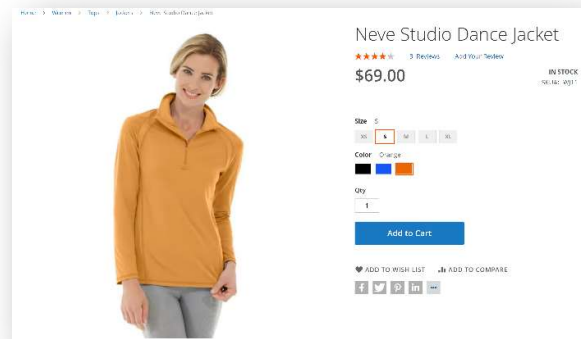
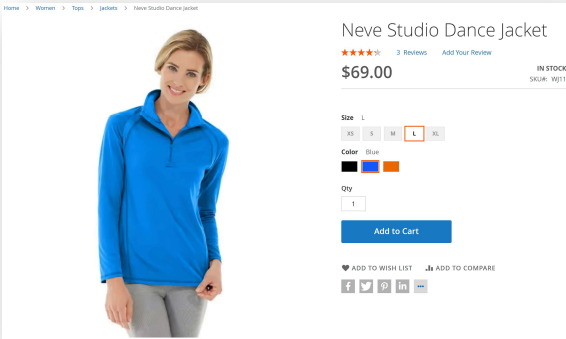




Step 3: John visits product page [Neve Studio Dance Jacket](#) for his wife. His wife has size "S" and prefers "orange".

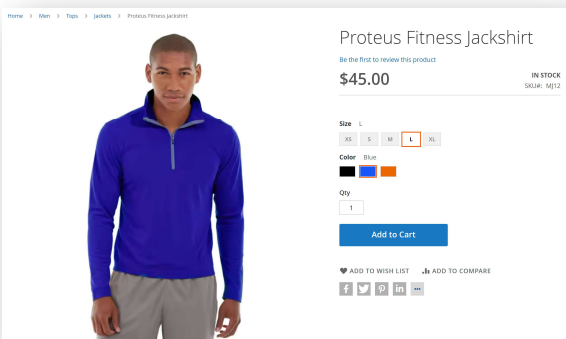
→ Size "L" and color "blue" auto-selected as previously selected for super attributes

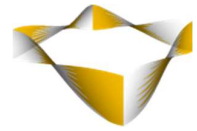
→ John selects size "S" and color "orange"



Step 4: John comes back to product page [Proteus Fitness Jackshirt](#)

→ Size "L" and color "blue" auto-selected as previously selected for this SKU
