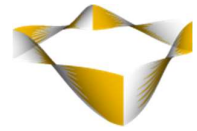
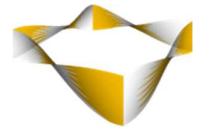

1. Introduction

[JaJuMa Category Grid Callouts](#) for Magento 2 enables you to add eye-catching callouts to category grids in your Magento 2 store.



2. Installation

For installing the extension, follow installation process as with any Magento Extension.

2.1. Extension Installation via composer

For installing the extension via composer, follow installation process as with any Magento Extension from Magento Marketplace.

2.2. Manual Extension Installation via FTP

For manual installation by FTP, please follow these steps:

Before Installing

1. We recommend you to duplicate your live store on a staging/test site and try installation on your staging/test site before deploying to your live store
2. Backup Magento files and the store database

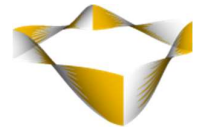
Please Note: It's very important to backup all themes and extensions in Magento before installation, especially when you are working on a live server.

We strongly recommend you to do not skip this step.

Upload the Extension

1. Log into your hosting space via a FTP client (e. g. FileZilla, WinSCP, cuteFtp)
2. Create Folder: <magentoroot>/app/code/Jajuma/CategoryCallouts
3. Unzip extension package and upload files into:
<magentoroot>/app/code/Jajuma/CategoryCallouts
4. Enter and run the following commands at the command line:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade  
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```



3. Extension Scope

[JaJuMa Category Grid Callouts](#) for Magento 2 supports adding callouts to category grids in your Magento 2 store with following options:

- Show on all pages or on specific pagination page only
- Choose between 2 callout types:
 - Banner or
 - Grid Items
- Configure the position in category grid for each callout
- Configure the page for each callout (if not show on all pages)
- Select category(s) in which the callout should be shown
- Configure Store/Store view in which the callout should be shown
- Manage content for callouts via Page Builder / WYSIWYG Editor

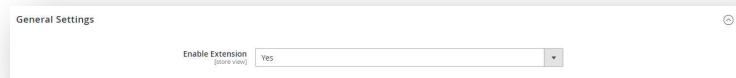

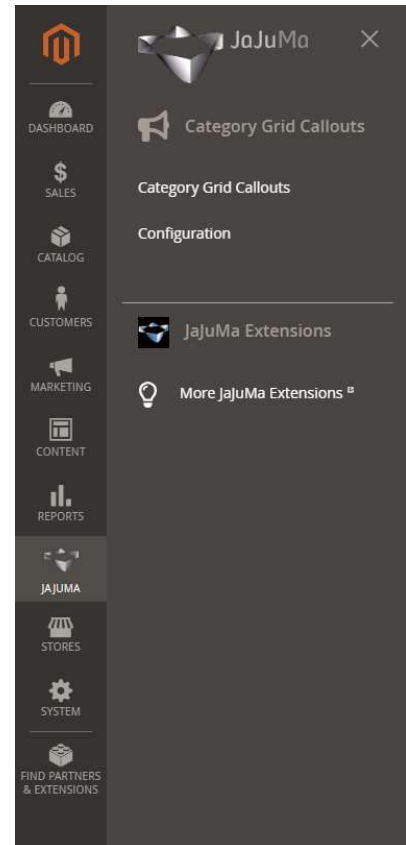

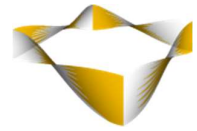

4.1. General Configurations

The general configurations in

JaJuMa -> Category Grid Callouts -> Configuration

provides the option to

- Enable/Disable the extension
-> For details see section 4.3 - Category Grid Callouts Create/Edit View
and
- Configure/Select your category grid layout
Including the usual options to search & filter items as well as delete items:

4.1.1. Enable/Disable

The “Enable Extension” dropdown allows you to enable / disable the callout extension:

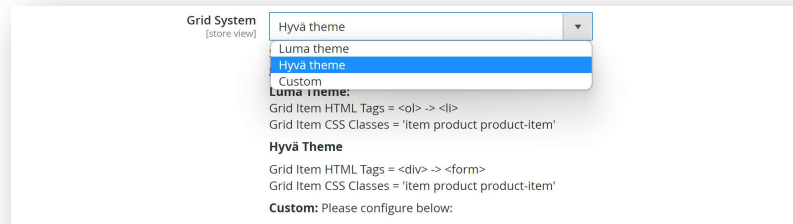
- Yes → Callout extension is enabled
- No → Callout extension is disabled

4.1.2. Configure/Select Category Grid Layout

The “Grid System” dropdown allows you to select or configure the HTML structure used for category grids on your site:



- **Luma Theme**

Select this option when your site is using a Luma based theme with

- Grid Item HTML Tags = ->
- Grid Item CSS Classes = 'item product product-item'
- "nth-child" CSS-selectors for margins / alignments in your grid

- **Hyvä Theme**

Select this option when your site is using Hyvä Theme with

- Grid Item HTML Tags = <div> -> <form>
- Grid Item CSS Classes = 'item product product-item'
- No "nth-child" CSS-selectors for margins / alignments in your grid

- **Custom**

Select this option for custom grids and configure following options:

- **Grid Item HTML Tags**
Please input the grid parent tag and the grid item tag used for category grids on your site separated by comma.
e.g. 'ul,li', 'ol,li', 'div,form'
- **Grid Item CSS Classes**
Please input the CSS classes used for category grid items on your site.
Default is 'item product product-item'.
- **Output Dummy elements**
Option to add dummy elements to fix grid alignment.
Set to yes if "nth-child"-selectors are used on your site for grid margins/alignment.
Otherwise, set to no.

4.3. Category Grid Callouts Create/Edit View

When

- click **Add Category Grid Callout Button** or
- select **"Edit"** in Action column

in Category Grid Callouts Overview

you will get to the Category Grid Callouts Create/Edit View.

This view allows you to configure and modify category grid callouts as described in following sections.



4.3.1. Status

The “Status” toggle allows you to enable / disable the callout:

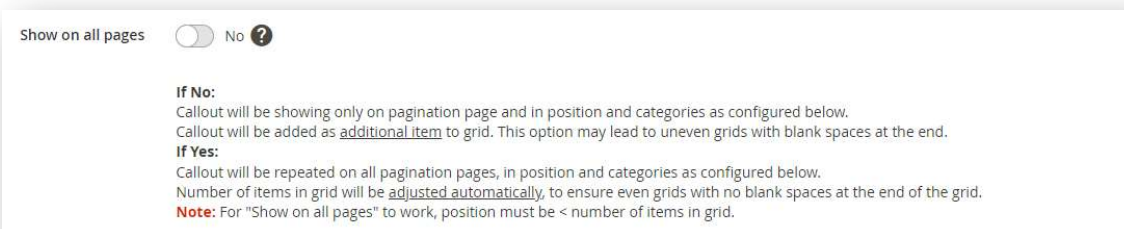
- Yes → Callout is enabled
- No → Callout is disabled



4.3.2. Show on all pages

The “Show on all pages” toggle allows you to control if the callout is repeated on all pagination pages or displayed only on a specific pagination page.

- **If No:**
Callout will be showing only on pagination page and in position and categories as configured below.
Callout will be added as additional item to grid. This option may lead to uneven grids with blank spaces at the end.
- **If Yes:**
Callout will be repeated on all pagination pages, in position and categories as configured below.
Number of items in grid will be adjusted automatically, to ensure even grids with no blank spaces at the end of the grid.
Note: For "Show on all pages" to work, position must be < number of items in grid.





4.3.3. Name

The “Name” input field allows you to define a name for the callout.
The name is only used to identify the callout in the overview

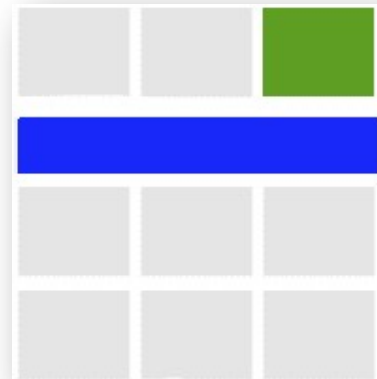
Name *

Input the name for your category grid callout.

4.3.4. Type

The “Type” dropdown allows you to choose between 2 callout types supported by the extension:

- **Banner:**
Callout will be added as a grid item with full width.
- **Grid Item:**
Callout will be added as a grid item with same width as a product item.



Note:

Grid Items are not showing in category view list mode.

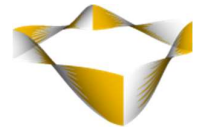

Note: Grid Items are not showing in category view list mode.

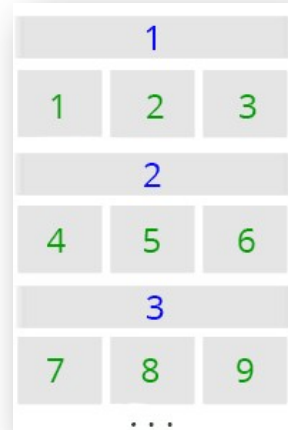




4.3.5. Position


The “Position” input field allows you to configure the position in which the callout will be shown.

- **For type "Banner":**
Position equals the row number in grid in which the callout will be showing.
- **For type "Grid Item":**
Position equals the item slot number in grid in which the callout will be showing.



Position *

Input the position for your category grid callout.
For type "Banner": Position equals the row number in grid in which the callout will be showing.
For type "Grid Item": Position equals the item slot number in grid in which the callout will be showing.



4.3.6. Page

The “Page” input field allows you to configure pagination page on which your callout should be showing.

(This option is only available if "Show on all pages" = "No")

Page *

Input the pagination page on which your category grid callout should be showing.
 (only if "Show on all pages" = "No")



4.3.7. Categories

To show the callout in all categories set the toggle

Show on all Categories → Yes

Show on all Categories Yes

If Yes:
Callout will be to all categories.

If No:
Callout will be added only to categories as configured below.

Or set the toggle

Show on all Categories → No

to choose the categories in which your callout from “Categories” dropdown:

Categories *

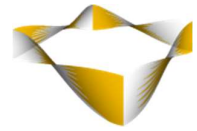
Choose the categories to which your category grid callout should be added.

4.3.8. Store View

The “Store View” selection allows you to select the store (view) scope in which your callout should be applied.

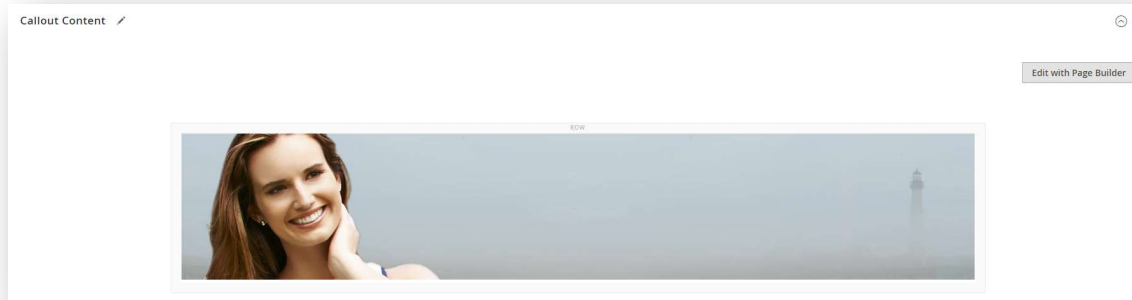
Store View *

- All Store Views
- Main Website
- Main Website Store
- Default Store View



4.3.9. Callout Content

The “Callout Content” tab allows you to edit and manage the content for your callout. Content is managed by Page Builder / WYSIWYG Editor and can be images, text, video or any HTML/CSS/JS...

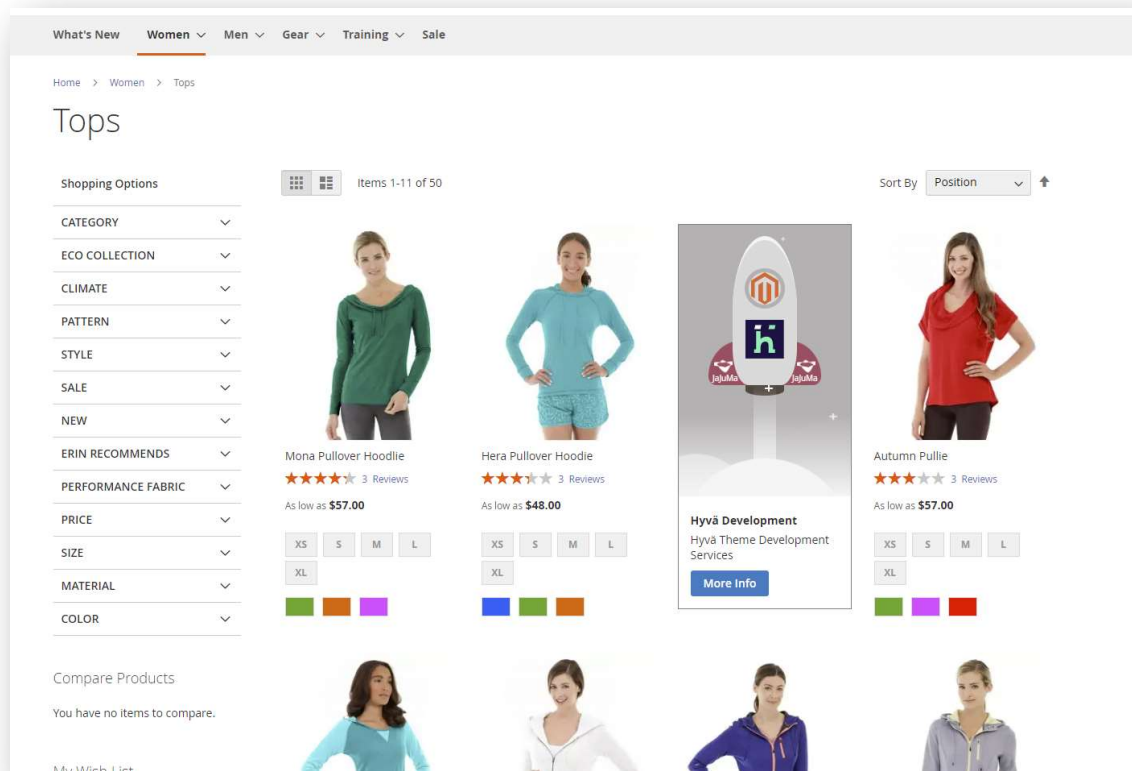
